VOLUNTEER DESCRIPTIONS

ELEMENTARY CATECHISTS – teach with a partner on Sunday morning from 9:45-10:45 from mid-September to early May. The curriculum is provided.

HIGH SCHOOL YOUTH MINISTRY – currently meeting on Sunday from 12:15-1:45. Includes engaging catechesis, service opportunities, and social activities with our dynamic young people – forming disciples who will shape the future of the Catholic Church!

ADULT FAITH FORMATION – *MANY* opportunities here to provide spiritual nourishment to adults of all ages – lead a study, be a presenter, facilitate a home program....the possibilities are endless!

RCIA- Join the team of catechists who journey with our RCIA catechumens and candidates. Become a sponsor or Godparent. Evangelize, welcome, and help to form new Catholics!

FIRST SACRAMENTS – Help prepare our 2nd grade students for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Holy Communion. Classes meet on alternate Sundays, 9:45-10:45 from October through mid-May.
